#### 2021 Time Test - Spera filly - Bonnieweka Syndicate

**Syndication has been completed to race the 2021 Time Test – Spera filly** – currently nicknamed 'Bonnieweka', a full sister to three time winner Maryweka and a half sister to successful fillies, Morweka and Wekaforce.

**Breeders:** Les, Janine and Joseph Wallace have retained a 10% share to race the filly and pay for their share the same as all other syndicate members. There is no right of purchase on the filly

**Breakers**: Bonnieweka began her education at Kiltannon Stables under the guidance of Mark Forbes. The process went very smoothly and Bonnie returned to the Wairarapa where her education will continue under the guidance of Trainer Jim Wallace of Ardsley Stud.

**Trainer**: Bonnieweka will travel to the South Island in late September and into the hands of Trainer Terri Rae, who alongside Breeder and Weka Racing Manager Les Wallace will manage the filly's racing career. The focus initially is on a late 2yo - 3yo campaign. If the filly shows ability going forward then travel could be on the agenda – again that decision will be based on the the filly's ability and the decision of trainer Terri Rae.

**Length of Lease:** The lease will commence in May of 2023 for a period of three years which will cover the filly's two, three and four year old term. We ask all syndicate members to make a personal commitment to two years with a right to review for the third year. If the filly measures up and shows talent Les and Janine are open to extending the lease, just as they have done with the other Weka fillies. In consultation with the syndicate, the lease can also be terminated if the filly does not measure up – however based on her size and scope and the talent of her sisters and our trainer, we are confident that Bonnie will live up to our hopeful expectations.

**Number of shares:** 100 - each share is valued at \$35. \$30 is payable for racing expenses and \$5 fee per share for administration

**Pearl Bonus Series:** The filly has been registered for the Pearl Bonus Series

**Accounting and Administration:** Syndicate members will receive a quarterly copy of the transaction statement each month with the bank balances.

**Syndicate Payouts:** Should the filly be successful on track, payouts are done either annually or as funds accumulate. NZTR pay out prize money less 10% for the Trainer and 5% for the jockey. The balance is paid to the syndicate.

# All about Spera from the Thoroughbred News archives 25/11/2009 by Jeff Dore

The John Sargent trained Spera (3 B. F Country Reel – Blue Hope, by Bigstone) appeared like a filly with plenty of upside when recording her first win at start four, in the Scott Wenn Racing Stables Maiden Three-Year-Old over 1400 metres at Te Aroha on Wednesday.

After finishing first and second respectively in two trials before racing, Spera ran second to promising galloper Shigeru (Ishiguru) on debut at Te Aroha, while her subsequent performances for fourth to another sharp sort, Dasoudi (Elusive City) and sixth to Groovy Guru (Ishiguru) also contained merit.

She became the second three-year-old filly from the stable to impress with blinkers on in recent days after Better Together (3 B. F. Volksraad – Morangie, by Cache Of Gold) disposed of her rivals at Te Rapa last Sunday, under a similar front running ride by Mark Du Plessis. Aboard Spera, Du Plessis pushed on to lead at the 900 metres from a position wide in a line of four after clearing the gates nicely and following a brief respite she was tackled again nearing the home turn.

Under minimal urging she kicked three lengths clear at the 300 metres, giving her rider an opportunity to ease near the line while maintaining the margin.

The emphatic nature of the win was illuminated bν the ability performance of the second horse, Mercury Mistress (No Excuse Needed). Thought enough of to contest the group three Gold Trail Stakes won by St Germaine (Keeper) at Hastings in September, she was looking to give trainer Lance Noble an early double after Broadway Miss (4 B. M. O'Reilly -Montaine, by Centaine) had been competently handled by his stable apprentice Alvin Ng to record his first victory in the previous race, but Mercury Mistress was unable to bridge the gap.

She did have a two and a half length buffer over the third horse, Summer Storm (Bachelor Duke), though, suggesting the first pair were clearly superior. On good footing, the 1400 metres was covered in 1:23.39.

Spera was bred by Les and Janine Wallace at Karaka, in partnership with Stephen Goh with whom they share a breeding partnership. The Wallace's own this filly and she was was leased by Sargent for the Three Fillies Syndicate No.2 after she was withdrawn from the yearling sales in 2008.

Janine Wallace is the well-known administrator in the office of the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders Ass at Ellerslie and she reports that the filly's win has been a big thrill for her, Les and Stephen.

Sargent said, "She needs time to fill out and win, lose or draw she was going out after this and she'll be a very nice horse in the autumn."

# Sire of Bonnieweka - Time Test Time Test - Dubawi (IRE) - Passage of Time



Time Test is out of the Group One winning Dansili mare Passage Of Time and a family littered with winners to the highest level, including the multiple Group One winners Twice Over and Banshee Breeze and All At Sea, also successful at the highest level.

As is the European custom, Time Test was the lightly-raced winner of six races, including a brace of Group Two victories and was a Group One place getter in his native England and in North America.

Successful as a 2YO, he broke the Royal Ascot track record track record over 2000 metres at his second start the following season before firmly establishing himself among the elite level European gallopers. His deeds earned him a Timeform rating of 125.

"Time Test blew away the opposition at Royal Ascot as a three-year-old. Speed and acceleration were his main assets," his famed trainer Roger Charlton said.

Bred and raced by Prince Kallid Abdullah's Juddmonte Farms, Time Test was effective in top company from 1400 to 2000 metres and was blessed with what all breeders clamour for, a lightning turn of foot. Along with Galileo, Time Test's sire Dubawi, a great grandson of the legendary Mr Prospector, is globally acknowledged as the most pre-potent stakes producing stallion in the world today.

Consistency, adaptability, toughness and the ability to quicken off a good tempo are all attributes apparent in progeny that have given Time Test such an incredible start to his career, which include the stakes performers:
