(4) Format for Award Presentations

- 1. Awards will be presented by an industry representative (presenter).
- 2. Hosts introduce the category and the Award presenter.
- 3. A video will play depicting the Award finalists*.
- 4. Once the video finishes, the presenter will announce the winner. If you are the winner, please make your way *<u>quickly</u>* to the stage. Please access the stage by the stairs on the right-hand side (when facing the stage).
- 5. Winner's video will play out as awardee is making their way to the stage.
- 6. The presenter will hand the winner their trophy and shake their hand.
- 7. The winner will then be briefly interviewed by Michael Guerin or Jayne Ivil. **Please note** there will be no additional speaking opportunity outside of this interview.
- 8. When the interview concludes, the winner and presenter will descend the stairs on the left of the stage (when facing) an NZTR representative will greet you and lead you to the LOVERACING.NZ X SENZ Media Wall where our photographer will take a photo and an interview will be conducted with the LOVERACING.NZ content team.
- 9. The winner can then return to their seat.

* Please note there will be a finalist graphic only for the Owner of the Year Award and LOVERACING.NZ Award for Contribution to Media, Digital and Content, rather than a video.

Please be aware there is a media crew filming during the ceremony for broadcast on Trackside at a later date. You may be approached for an interview or comment during or after the ceremony.
